Why Permits Matter for Basement Renovations in Markham

Legal Requirements and Compliance

Any major basement renovation in Markham must comply with the Ontario Building Code and local zoning bylaws. Obtaining a building permit ensures your project meets structural, electrical, and safety standards required by law.

Protecting Your Investment and Home Resale Value

A permitted renovation provides peace of mind and protects your long-term investment. When you sell your home, buyers and realtors often request proof of permits. Unauthorized work can delay or cancel a home sale.

Risks of Skipping Permits

Failing to get a permit can result in serious consequences such as:

- Stop work orders from the city
- Fines or penalties
- Complications with home insurance
- Orders to undo or demolish unpermitted work

When Do You Need a Basement Renovation Permit in Markham?

Projects That Require a Permit

- Removing or constructing walls
- Basement underpinning or lowering
- Adding new bedrooms or bathrooms
- Installing or moving plumbing or electrical systems
- Creating a second suite or separate entrance



Minor Renovations That May Not Require a Permit

- Painting, flooring, and trim work
- Cabinet installation (non-load bearing)
- Cosmetic updates that do not affect structure or systems

How to Apply for a Basement Renovation Permit in Markham

Step-by-Step Application Process

1. Prepare drawings and floor plans
2. Complete the application form from the City of Markham
3. Submit documentation either online or in person
4. Pay the permit fees
5. Await review and approval before beginning construction

What Documents Are Required

- Detailed architectural drawings
- Site plan and proposed layout
- Electrical, HVAC, and plumbing details (if applicable)

Permit Fees and Processing Times

Fees vary based on project size and scope. Most basement renovation permits cost between \$200 to \$1,500. Processing typically takes 2–4 weeks, depending on project complexity.



Basement Second Suites – Special Permit Considerations

What Is a Legal Basement Apartment or Second Suite?

A second suite is a self-contained unit with its own kitchen, bathroom, and sleeping space. In Markham, these must follow specific zoning rules.

Fire Code, Egress Windows, and Separate Entrances

Legal suites must have:

- Proper egress windows
- Fire separation between units
- Dedicated entrances and exits

Parking and Zoning Requirements

The City of Markham may require one off-street parking space per unit. Always check local zoning bylaws for specific requirements.

Inspections During the Renovation Process

Key Inspection Stages

Inspections typically occur during:

- Framing
- Plumbing rough-in
- Electrical work
- Insulation and vapor barrier
- Final walk-through

Who Performs the Inspections

Certified building inspectors from the City of Markham conduct all mandatory inspections. Homeowners or contractors must schedule each inspection at appropriate stages.

How to Schedule an Inspection

Once your permit is approved, instructions to book inspections will be included in the documentation. You can also schedule through the city's website.

Yes, if your renovation involves structural, plumbing, or electrical changes.

How long does it take to get a permit approved?

Usually 2–4 weeks depending on application completeness and project complexity.

Can I apply for a permit myself or do I need a contractor?

Homeowners can apply directly, but many choose to work with contractors who handle this.

What are the most common reasons permits are denied?

Incomplete drawings, zoning violations, or missing documentation.

Is there a fine for not having a permit in Markham?
